What: The Grand Opening of the We-Hin-Ah-Pay Trail

The We-Hin-Ah-Pay Trail is 5.25 miles. It passes through Camp Friedlander, Cub World, Peterloon Fields and Camp Craig at the Dan Beard Scout Reservation. Key points along the trail will be marked with QR codes providing information of historical interest.

When: Saturday, October 7 from 9 am to 12 pm

Where: Registration will be at Camp Friedlander at the Spider Shelter near the Administration Building. The Trail starts and ends at the We-Hin-Ah-Pay sign at the entrance to Camp Friedlander.

Why: Join the fun and fellowship of being one of the first to hike the We-Hin-Ah-Pay Trail. Get the Grand Opening patch & metal.

Cost: Free to hike. Patches and metals available for purchase.

Register: Register for free online at DanBeard.org on the calendar.

The first 100 to register are eligible to purchase special Grand Opening issues, see details below.



100 special Grand Opening patches & metals will be available for those who hike on Sat., Oct. 7. These will be reserved from 9am-11am the day of the hike for the first 100 that registered online. After 11am they will be available to any hiker. Cost is \$5 per patch and \$10 per metal.

Regular trail patches & metals will also be available the day of the hike. Cost is \$4 per patch and \$7 per metal or \$10 for both.



The Agony Trail was in operation from the 1960's to the 1990's at Dan Beard Scout Reservation. We recently found a large number of the last patch issued. These will be on sale for \$5 at the Grand Opening.
